ENGINEER'S LOG

Problem of Government Interference.

The AFPRO has recently engaged in certain activities against the undersigned Engineer and documented those activities concerning the conduct of my Engineering work. Those activities have interfered with the proper conduct of my authorized work and caused a significant impact to the United States.

Cause of AFPRO Organization.

The division chief has sent papers to Headquarters and asked to change the AFPRO organization affecting my Engineering position for manufacturing. The changes were never discussed and were a surprise when the documents were discovered. Headquarters rejected the division chief's request to reassign the Engineer from the Manufacturing Operations Division to the Manufacturing Assessment Branch. The division chief had already taken steps to have the branch chief assert authority in the Manufacturing Engineering function before the requested reorganization was rejected by HQ AFSC. The division chief's plot against my work has already caused a significant impact because of the hostile supervisory industrial engineer attempting to influence my official Engineering activities.

Actions Against the United States

The AFPRO together with the Los Angeles Air Force personnel office have acted against my Engineering work authorized by higher headquarters and by the laws and also by all of the current contracts. The reasons for the actions have not been revealed by the division chief although the Space Division is probably involved through the personnel office because of long standing rivalry by the SPOs against the AFPRO and their erroneous superiority attitude. The division chief seems at this time to have joined with those aggressors against my work. The circumstance is very probable and not too surprising because of the rivalry. The actions of the division chief to help my rivals instead of stopping their interference is surprising and has contributed to the adverse consequence. The covert nature of the actions would seem to be motivated by an intention to conceal those actions from Headquarters. The attempted change to the organization would clearly result in removing the Engineer from the Headquarters control now preventing the AFPRO from continuing with the AFPRO plan. The plot necessarily requires the personnel office to design the technique for circumventing the proper authorities now standing in their way. The persons now conducting the actions do not have any authority for the field Engineering and their agenda is patently improper.

Consequences of the Interference

The interference has resulted in a negative impact to my Engineering effort. The Engineering for my work being conducted under all of the contracts at the location has been subjected to delays and the contractor has witnessed events by those involved causing confusion and doubt about my supervision of the contracts.
